

Y Club Member Car Park Policy

Dear Member

Car parking spaces at the club are limited, and demand can often exceed supply causing much frustration. Unfortunately there isn't an easy solution to this problem, and believe me, we have tried to find one! But by following a few rules we hope we can keep things running as smoothly as possible.

The car park is owned and operated by the Castlefield Hotel and rates are set at commercial levels. The charge for guests is £14 but by way of concession, members can park for up to 4 hours for £1 whilst using the club facilities. Anything over that is at the discretion of the hotel and, where members have been on the premises purchasing food and drink, then the standard charge may be waived. This concessionary rate only applies if the member is exclusively at the Castlefield facility and members going off-site at any time will be charged the £14 hotel rate.

The number of available spaces in the car park is controlled by a counter triggered by the issuing of tickets on entry and by the scanning of tickets on exit. If tickets are not scanned on exit then the counter will indicate the car park is full when in fact there are spaces available. This causes much frustration and members are strongly urged to always scan their tickets when exiting the car park (i.e. no tailgating).

Abuse of the concessionary rate or exiting without paying will result in the $\pounds 14$ hotel rate being applied and access to the club will be denied until this is paid.

We do hope you can understand why these rules are necessary and we thank you for your cooperation.
